What is CECE?

- CECE is a **employers' organization** founded in 1977 that represents an ample education and training companies in Spain.
- It has branches all over the Autonomous Communities via Federations and Associations.
- In addition, CECE contains about five thousand Teaching Centres, the population is around one million of students and sixty thousand teachers.

The main ambition of the training department of the ITE of the **CECE** is to deliver lifelong learning courses to all the workers of the Education Sector.

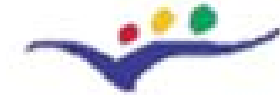
- Elaboration, development and delivery of **Lifelong learning courses** geared to the needs of staff in schools and other educational institutions

European Projects

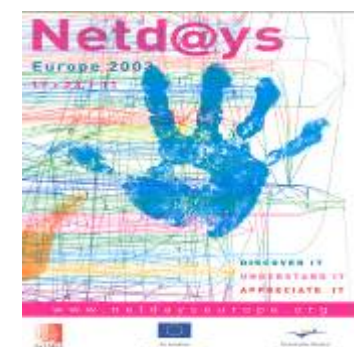
